Product Description

LUX ELEMENTS[®]-ADD PRO-MAK are solid boards made of thermoplastic copolyester. They feature high impact resistance and a good fire protection classification as well as being food compatible and fully recyclable.

LUX ELEMENTS®-ADD PRO-MAK serves as a hard plastic insert which is stuck onto the hard foam where a stable mounting is required, for example for a door hinge. Screws can be simply screwed in. The hinges mounted in this way hold even heavy glass doors firmly.
